You do not need another tool that gives you a generic response to a generic prompt. You need a better way to work through the questions that actually affect your next move.

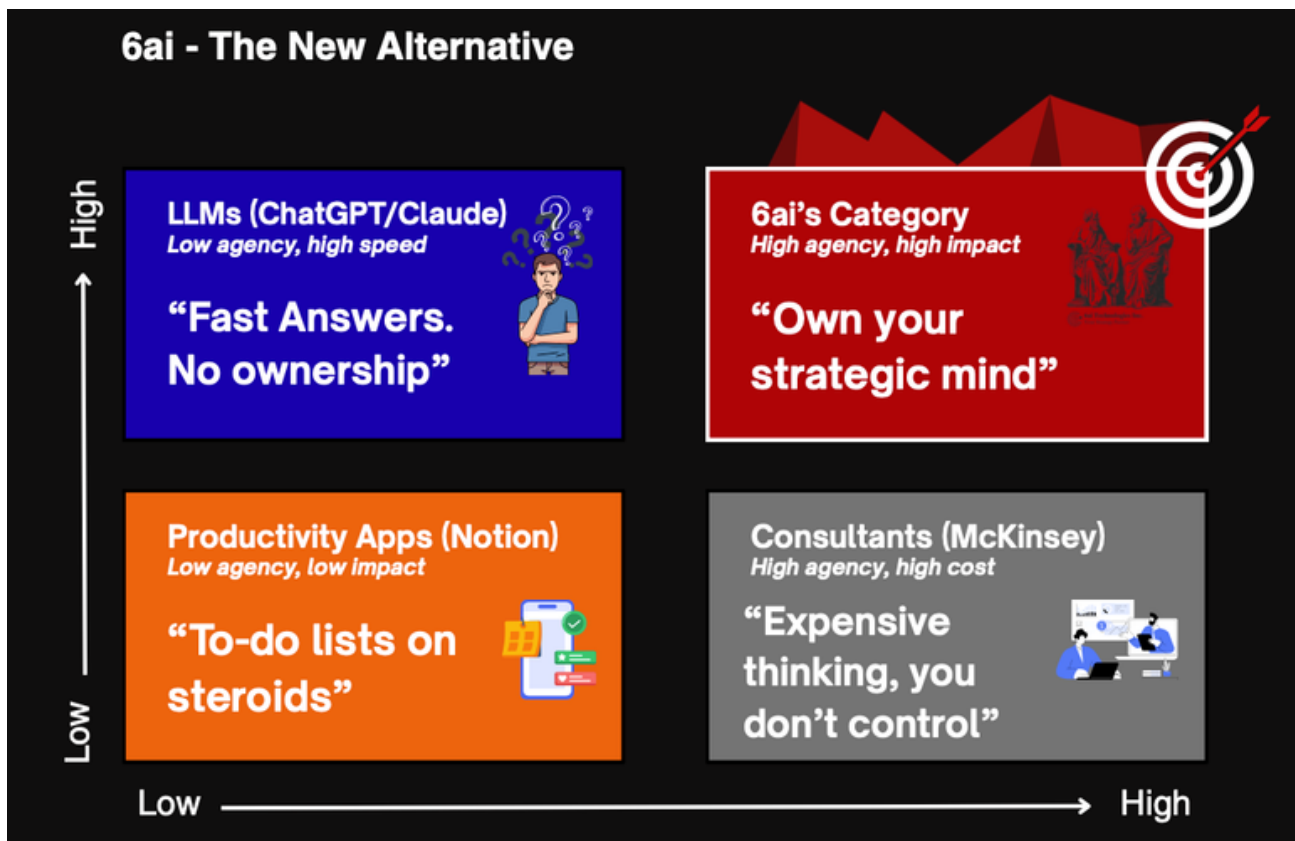
